Who you are: like your name, address, date of birth, nationality, race and gender, identity document, home language, passport, study permit, permanent residence.	We use this information to make decisions about your application, for internal planning purposes, to obtain funding and subsidies from government. We also need to verify some of the information you share with us, and we may use third-party service providers to help us. We use applicants' and students' information to create an institutional profile for obtaining funding from government. We report to schools about applicants.
How to reach you: like telephone number(s) and email address.	We use this information to stay in touch with you and send you important information.
How we might assist you: like your disability information.	We use this information to determine whether you need support for a disability.
What your background is: like education and employment history.	And, finally, there are some things we ask to help us get to know you better before we decide to admit you.
Manage our relationship: We collect and use information like banking details, dietary requirements and participation in sports and cultural activities	There is information we need to ensure that we can deliver the services you signed up for. Whether our service providers are in South Africa or other countries, they must agree to keep your information as safe and confidential as we do. And they may only use it for the reason we share it with them. We make sure that we have the necessary contracts in place before we share your information.

WE DON'T HOARD YOUR INFORMATION

We will not keep your information for longer than we need to for business reasons or longer than the law requires.
