## LIBRARY COPY (NO EMBARGO)

UPLOAD ALL OF THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTS IN THE SAME LIBRARY COPY SERVICE REQUEST:

1. **Thesis** in pdf format (name the file **Thesis**).  
[Do not upload an encrypted thesis file. Refer to point 2 in the notice below.]
2. An unsigned plagiarism declaration should be included **in the thesis** regarding the extent to which it represents your own work, both in concept and execution.
3. **Abstract** in pdf format (name the file **Abstract-Open**).
4. In the Comment box:

“I confirm that the uploaded files are the correct versions for the Library.”

## LIBRARY COPY (EMBARGO)

The thesis is embargoed namely, not made available on UCT’s digital repository OpenUCT for a specified period.

### INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY OR SENSITIVE CONTENT EMBARGO

UPLOAD ALL OF THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTS IN ONE LIBRARY SERVICE REQUEST:

1. **Thesis** in pdf format (name the file **Thesis**).  
[Do not upload an encrypted thesis file. Refer to point 2 in the notice below.]
2. **Abstract (neutralized)** in pdf format (name the file **Abstract-Restricted**).
3. **Abstract-Open** in pdf format (name the file **Abstract-Open**).
4. In the Comment box:

“I confirm that the uploaded files are the correct versions for the Library.”

### PUBLICATION PENDING EMBARGO

UPLOAD ALL OF THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTS IN ONE LIBRARY SERVICE REQUEST:

1. **Thesis** in pdf format (name the file **Thesis**).  
[Do not upload an encrypted thesis file. Refer to point 2 in the notice below.]
2. **Abstract-Open** in pdf format (name the file **Abstract-Open**).
3. In the Comment box:

“I confirm that the uploaded files are the correct versions for the Library.”

## **NOTICE:**

(1) All of the above documents must be uploaded as separate attachments in the SAME LIBRARY SERVICE REQUEST.

(2) Please do not upload an encrypted thesis file in PeopleSoft. UCT Libraries requires an accessible/unprotected thesis file to insert the copyright statement and the generic watermark. This is a requirement for all UCT shared theses and dissertations.
